



What is Discovery?

Discovering Personal Genius (DPG) is an employment planning tool and model for individual employment evaluation that results in a comprehensive vocational profile. Discovery uses a person-centered community-based assessment approach that focuses on observation and trial in real-time community activities to determine the strengths, skills and interests of the focus person. It also includes exploration through informational interviews of potential employers in the community.

Who Should Attend? This training is appropriate for vocational rehabilitation professionals, community rehabilitation providers, employment specialists/job developers, and others who support individuals with disabilities to gain employment in their community.
