

### **Slow Progress**

We seem to be moving the needle on Medicaid Block Grants:

In 2017, Congress came within a very narrow margin of passing national legislation with Medicaid Block Grants included.

In 2018, we found that Idaho Legislators were enthusiastic about Block Granting Medicaid – "flexibility" was the buzz word.

In 2019, we are finding even very conservative legislators saying that they do not think it is a good idea for Idaho.



## Blessings of Liberty Film Screenings

We screened the Idaho Developmental Disabilities Network's Film "Blessings of Liberty" in:

ICDD hosted the first screening of the Film "Blessings of Liberty" in the Idaho Capitol Building in Boise on February 7th during the 2019 legislative session.

- We had 225 Participants
- 14 Legislators were in attendance

#### Canyon County

- We screened the film in Nampa on June 18<sup>th</sup> 2019 at
- 49 participants were in attendance
- 2 legislators were in attendance

### TWIN FALLS

- The Coalition produced the Twin Falls screening of the film on June 25<sup>th</sup>
- 31 participants were in attendance
- 2 legislators were in attendance







- The Idaho Falls screening of the film took place on August 8<sup>th in</sup>.
- 41 Participants were in attendance
- 4 legislators were in attendance

### Coeur d'Alene

- We had 21 people, all from Coeur d'Alene and North
- And we had one legislator
- We also laid out plans to meet with individual legislators in smaller meetings



- The Leadership Academy took place on August 22-24 at the Riverside Hotel in Boise
- 43 Participants
- The event was sponsored by the Advocacy Coalition and the council.
- Contributions were made by all three organizations within the Developmental Disability Network – but the Council contributed the vast majority of \$.
